## Calhoun- Gilmer Career Center Draft Re-Entry Plan for 2020-2021

Note: This plan is an extremely flexible draft that maybe modified at anytime to meet the ever-changing needs of our students and teachers. The safety and wellbeing of our staff and students will be a priority. This re-entry plan has been developed with input from both counties' administrations, teachers, the WV Department of Education and the WV Health and Human Resources.

- Remote Learning Professional Development opportunities for CTE Instructors will be provided.
- Remote Learning opportunities for CTE students will be planned for. This should also include remote learning for students that may not have broadband.
- Arrival and Departure will be staggered and will always allow for social distancing of 6 ft. Students will only enter the building through the front main entrance. Departure will exterior doors at the Welding lab.
- Hallways will be clearly marked for the flow of travel.

- Students and staff will be temperature checked and screened for COVID 19.
- Students will be provided a location that fail screening.
- Visitors will be limited and only necessary personnel such Health Inspections and Fire Marshal inspections will be strongly recommended to be scheduled.
- Virtual meetings will be used whenever possible.
- Face masks or coverings will be required.
- PPE Training for correct use will be provided to staff.
- Face shields will be provided if necessary, for staff.
- Plexiglass Shields will be provided if requested for staff.
- Rubber gloves will be provided to each classroom.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided for each classroom.
- Classrooms will be arranged to allow social distancing.
- Chairs will be removed from the computer lab to allow for social distancing.
- Students will be trained to social distance at all times.
- Only the water dispenser will be used.
- A schedule for continual disinfecting will be developed.

- Funding for additional PPE and cleaning supplies are being sought out. This may include funding for an additional custodian.
- Class breaks will be held in the classroom.
- There will be no one permitted in the Commons area.
- Students will use classroom and lab restrooms. Those classrooms without a restroom will schedule restroom use.
- There will be no food sales available.
- 6S Protocol will be used to help facilitate continual disinfecting classrooms.

Additional notes:

- SBA Project to renovate our existing restrooms to become ADA compliant. This will include touchless, hand motion sinks, toilets, soap and paper towel dispensers.
- As mentioned, two competitive grant opportunities are being sought out. One for additional cleaning supplies and the other for professional development for CTE teachers to facilitate remote learning.
